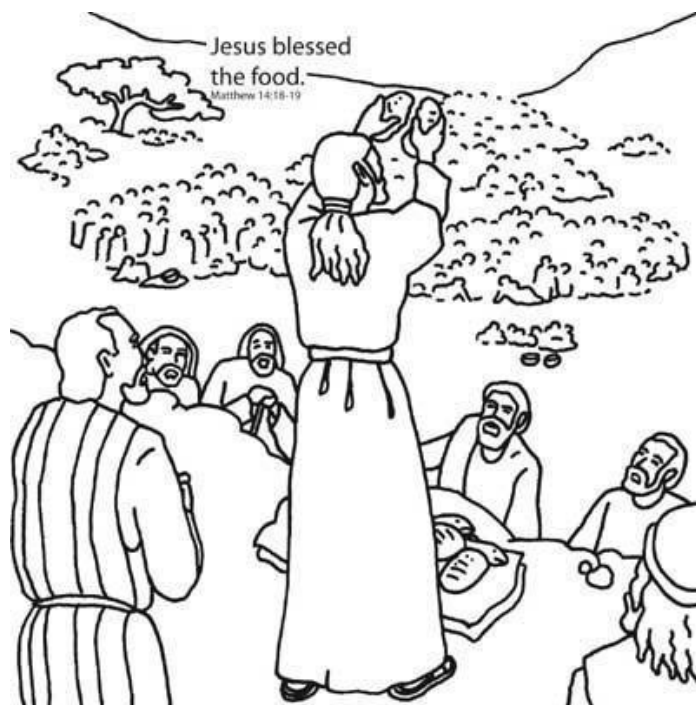

## St. Mary Financial Update

Below is a financial update thru March 31 and for those of you who skip to the bottom line...do not fear. Because of the generosity of our donors...at the end of March our income was greater in March 2020 then in 2019. However, because of the Church renovation and the designated building fund dollars that had to be paid out, Saint Mary is running at a loss for the fiscal year, but that does not mean we are broke!

We have enough funds to operate approximately thru May, before Saint Mary would need a withdrawal from the diocese. The building fund has bathroom renovation funds (\$25,000) and rectory updates (\$10,000) previously approved for disbursement. Other disbursements previously considered, but not approved, include a security system and a Mass streaming system and an enhanced website.

Adjustments from prior accounting periods include the separation of restricted Community Kitchen Outreach funds into a new general ledger account. Please email me with any questions.
