Have pity on the weakness of our faith.

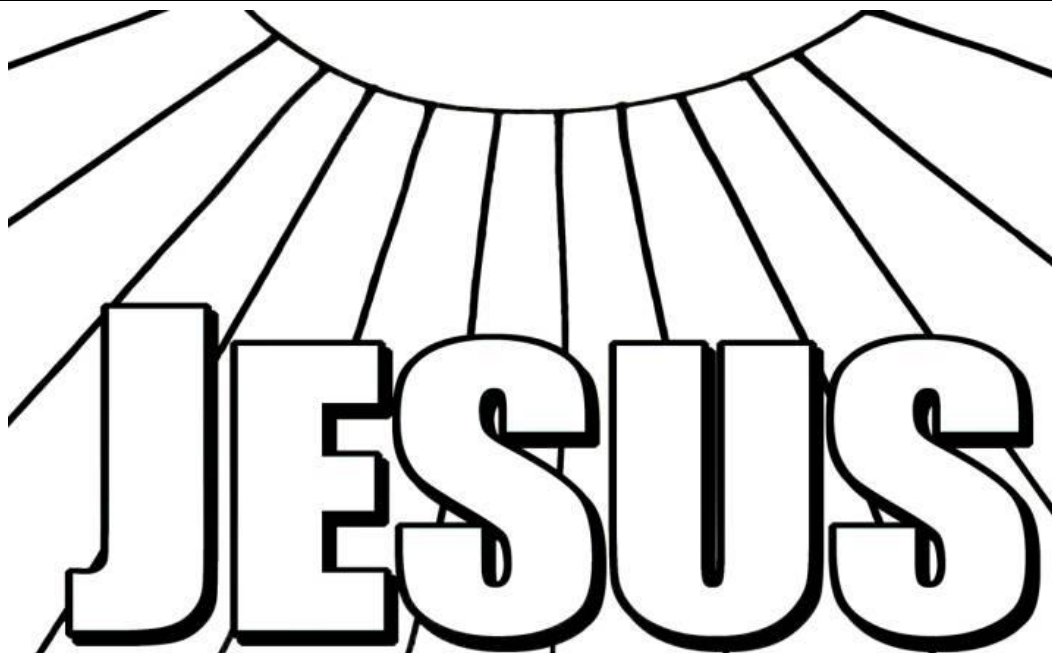
Have pity on those whom we love.

The Church must be sanitized after all masses, so those who attend the weekday masses are expected to take care of sanitizing the church on those days.
