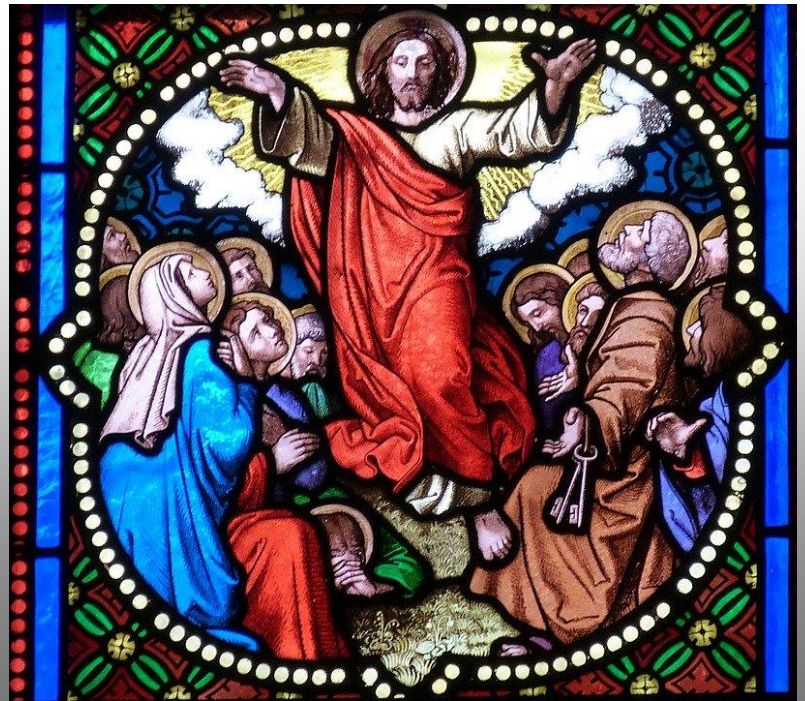

evangelizing all those who seek your Son.

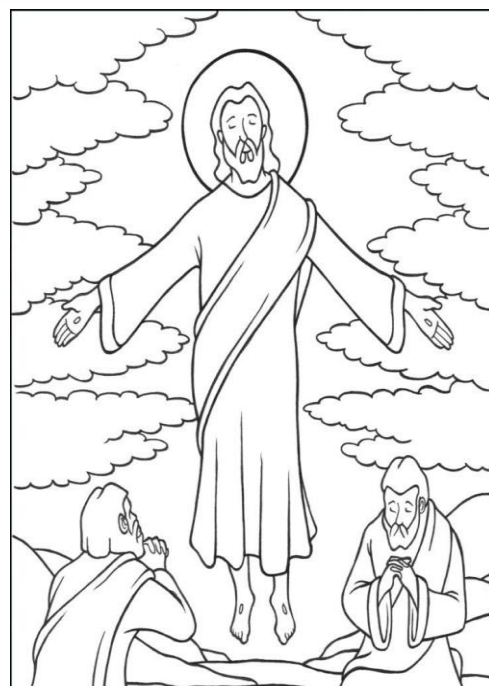
