

AREFLECTION

As summer hits mid-stride, it's as if we are still waiting to begin the summer festivities. Our lives have been disrupted, shook-up, and redefined, but the treasury of faith, <u>our Eucharist</u>, remains safe in the tabernacle. The faithful have been to confession and have prepared in the way we know how, to expect the unexpected, and be ready for anything, including a return to the Father, mortal death.

Faith in God leads us to turn to him alone as our first origin and our ultimate goal, and neither to prefer anything to him nor to substitute anything for him (CCC#229). Anything...the catechism states. So, in this time of world health crisis, when the American system itself is under attack, God is foremost in our minds and can't be substituted by health, money, food, drink, power, sex, or any human temptation.

Say the first half of Psalm 124:8, "Our help is in the name of the Lord," and most Catholics will respond, "who made heaven and earth." We pray this verse at every Christian burial, and it is our strength, this trust in the Lord. So, how is trust in the Lord nurtured?

Through the supernatural gifts of faith, hope, and love. Given to us as grace, to accept and magnify, or alternatively, to reject.


So where to find the strength to accept God's grace. Well, as corny as it sounds, we turn to prayer. Prayer through Jesus Christ our Lord, or prayers of intercession to Mother Mary or to the Communion of Saints. Prayer becomes ever more integral if we are separated from the Eucharist, where grace freely flows through the Holy Mass, the meeting place of heaven and earth.

So that's it, Father John, you ask, just pray to God and receive the Sacraments? Well this is how we accept grace, but to serve his people, we must also find ways to give love to others. This may be as close as the Community Kitchen, or as far as our Haiti collection fund. There are many ways to imitate Christ, and each of us is called to a different path. An America that turns to God for answers, how's that for non-partisan politics? It is not in us to be more than we are, but through God, all things are possible.
