A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

There are two definitions of community. Community is... a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common. And a community is... a feeling of fellowship with others, as a result of sharing common attitudes, interests, and goals.

Place is easy enough to identify, it centers around our Parish churches. Likewise, the particular characteristic is also easy to identify; we are catholic as Christians and we are Catholic as members of the one, the holy, the catholic and the apostolic faith of St. Mary and St. Joan of Arc.

The second definition is harder to quantify. Fellowship is a friendly association around shared interests. Fellowship comes from the feelings individuals have and actions that they take to engender friendship. Does this describe our church communities? Do we ever act against fellowship through jealousy, envy, malice, gossip, mean-spiritedness or vengeful feelings?

What are our common attitudes? Following Christ, this would imply love, mercy, forgiveness, strength in suffering, loyalty, honor, integrity, humility and dignity. Wow! There is a short list for you to compare your attitudes to the common attitudes flowing from Christ.

Common interests vary greatly within the church. Children, moms, dads, widows and widowers, single people, and religious vocations account for a large number of interests. But in common, we have the running of our church, the organization of its liturgies, fund-raising, clubs, study-groups, and our charitable interests. At Saint Mary the Community Kitchen is a shared responsibility and interest.

Shared goals center on the teachings of Christ. Consider these examples... Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and love your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 22:37-39). Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation (Mark 16:15). If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me (Luke 9:23). Whoever rejects me and does not accept my words has something to judge him: the word that I spoke, it will condemn him on the last day (John 12:48).

From the words of Jesus our shared goals flow: the good of the church, care for the poor and marginalized, hospitality, and helping those who need help. May we continue to be a strong community whose shared goals are both the center of our philosophy and our life in Christ.
