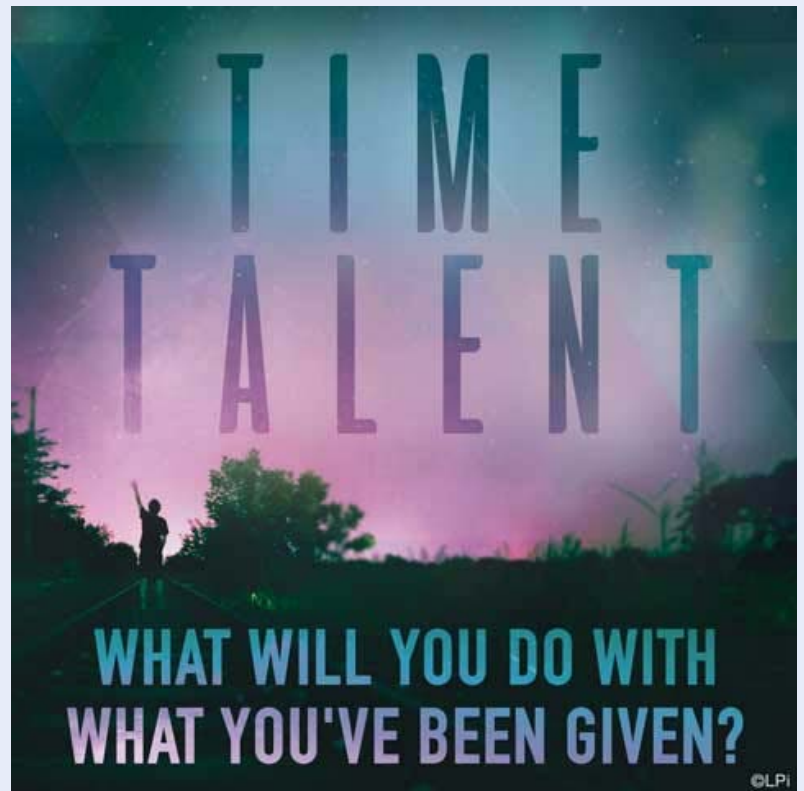

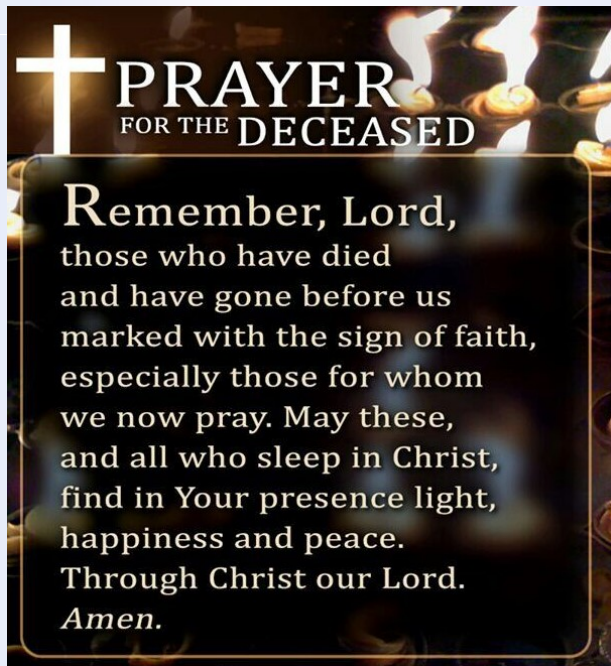

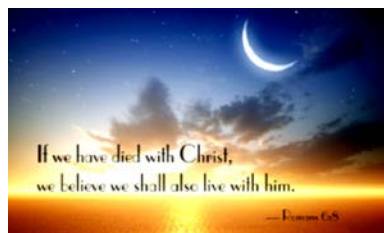
November is dedicated to the poor souls of purgatory. As good Catholics we pray for all these souls with compassion and mercy, knowing that we too may need to rely on the prayers of the living.



November also reflects on the time of our pilgrimage to heaven; the season when hope moves us towards longing for the reward of eternal life. We think about those things we did and did not do looking towards our own certain mortality.

November includes the last portion of the liturgical year. As the end of the Church year approaches we consider the end times, both our own and the world's. The liturgical year concludes with the Feast of Christ the King.
