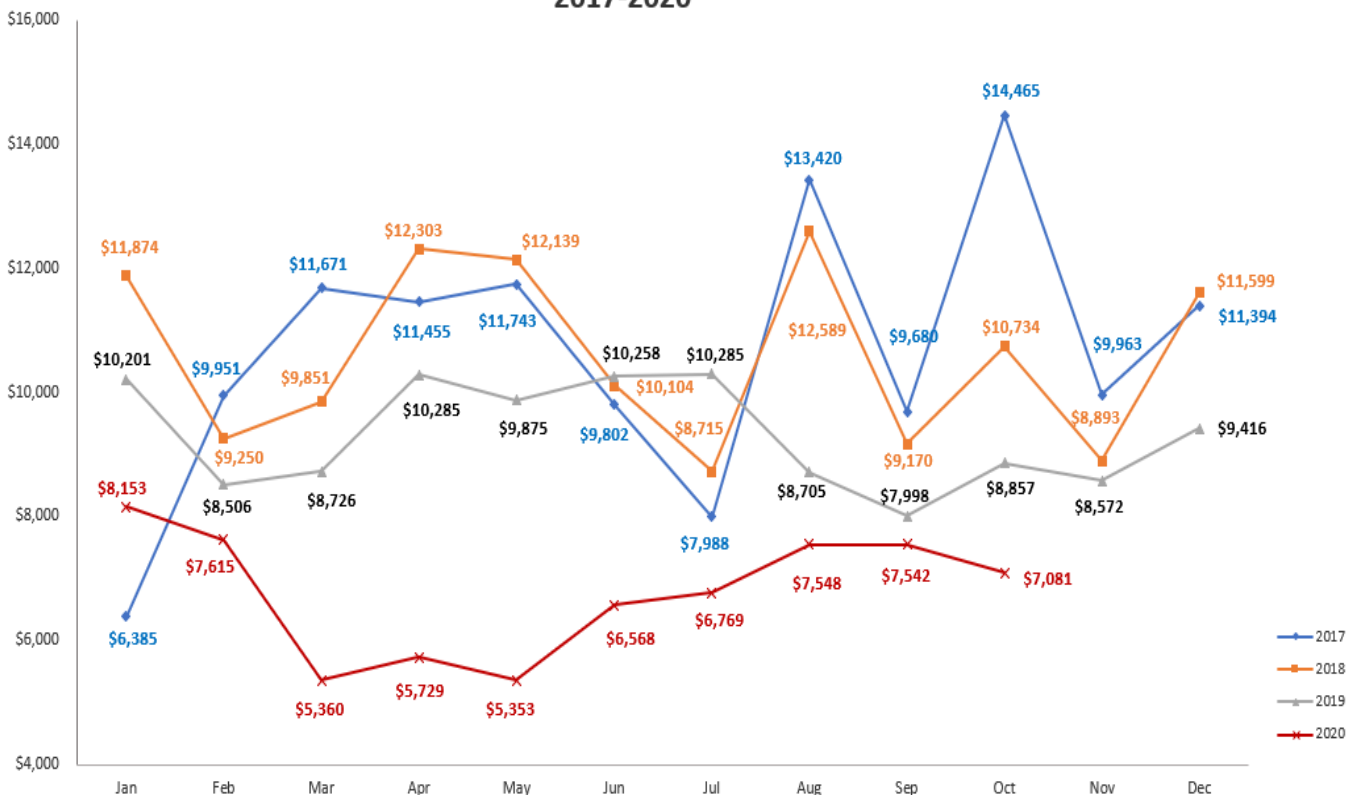
A FINANCIAL UPDATE
