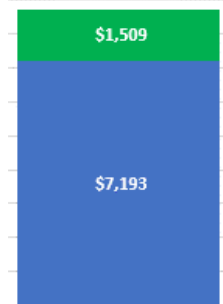

# A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

The Baptism of our Lord is the official end of the Church Christmas season. We have been contemplating the Nativity since Advent began and we have looked at John the Baptist in detail over that time.

It seems particularly apropos that Advent begins with John the Baptist and Christmas ends with the Baptism of Christ, by John the Baptist. Meanwhile, in our lives, the winter cold has surrounded us, but the days are lengthening and we know someday Spring will come to Sullivan County.

And just when we thought things could not get any nuttier, current events have slapped us across the face and forced us into new problems, equally upsetting as pandemic disharmony or racial injustice. Anyone who is not upset with 2020 has the foibles of 2021 to deal with. And hopes for normalcy amid our current problems seem distant or unreachable.

Even though the season we begin Monday is referred to as “Ordinary Time,” we can see that the times are quite extraordinary. So where do we

turn to heal our bruised psyches? Quite simply, we turn to God, to our Lord Jesus Christ, and the power of the Holy Spirit.

We rely on the supernatural virtues God gifts us: faith, hope, and love. Faith turns us constantly toward God. Faith transforms our doubt into the certainty that Jesus Christ is our salvation and strength and the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. Hope leads us to understand that like Jesus Christ, we will be raised from the dead to eternal life. Continual conversion lends our hope, power; power to change ourselves and change the world. Love guides us to share that love in real ways; shared as love of self, family, friends, and strangers.

Ordinary time will naturally flow into Lent, our season of repentance. I encourage you to move forward bravely into this New Year and constantly seek the grace and peace of faith, hope, and love. As we look forward let us constantly seek the good and the True in our imitation of Christ. If we follow Christ faithfully, we can rest in His peace, even amidst the worries of the world.
