A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

I was contemplating ways to speak about the repentant nature of Lent. *Repent* is defined as to “feel or express sincere regret or remorse about one’s sin.” I was surprised by this definition, because we all feel remorse for sin. But Lent is a special time we consider repentance more deeply. As a way to see more clearly, I looked in the Catechism to see what the Church has to say about the repentance of Lent.

By the solemn forty days of Lent the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert. Jesus' temptation reveals the way in which the Son of God is Messiah, contrary to the way Satan proposes to him and the way men wish to attribute to him. This is why Christ vanquished the Tempter for us: "For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sinning." Jesus invites sinners to the table of the kingdom: "I came not to call the righteous, but sinners."

Jesus invites us to conversion, continual conversion, without which one cannot enter the kingdom. For Lent to be enriching we embrace that idea of conversion because each human being is lured through temptation to sin. To reach the ideal of repentance in Lent we rely on the tools given us by the Church, *prayer, fasting, and almsgiving*.

In the practices of Lent, we practice the conversion wherein Jesus invites us to the transformation without which we cannot enter the kingdom. We experience God’s overarching mercy for us as we prepare to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ, the proof of God’s love for us.

Also in Lent, we re-read and re-live the great events of salvation history in the Bible. The scriptures become our means to understand the many facets of repentance and conversion of Lent as they point to Christ in the works of the prophets, spiritual leaders, and the evangelists.
