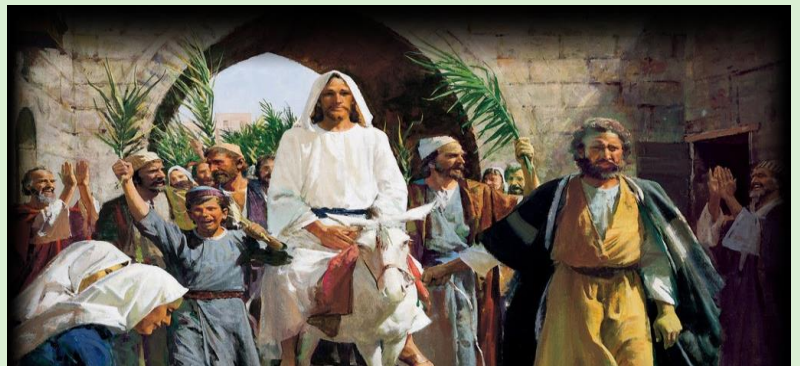

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

In the blink of an eye five weeks has flown by and we find ourselves at Palm Sunday. We celebrate Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem that oh so quickly turns towards Jesus' Passion and Death. This reminds us as we turn to Holy Week it is the culmination of our time in repentance and prayer.

Capped by Easter, the Triduum begins Thursday. The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday.

Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are:

- Mass of the Lord's Supper
- Good Friday of the Lord's Passion
- Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord

Several changes due to Covid restrictions are being observed, perhaps for the last time as restrictions are loosened beginning April 6.

The changes to ceremony I will announce as a change when they occur, so don't get worried.

Easter is especially exciting with the entrance of Sunshine and Zach into the Church at the Easter Vigil. They are both extremely excited and I hope the community can come to the most sacred of Masses where we live out the Easter tradition in the acceptance of the elect into our assembly, and they each celebrate the most holy of Sacraments...His precious body.

Good Friday's service is at St. Joan of Arc, so I especially invite you to Jasonville for a prayerful service. Holy Saturday Mass will start after the sun has set (9:00pm) and will start with the blessing of the fire and the water. The first part is candlelight, so if you have never seen this, it is worth staying up for. It is the high point of our liturgical year, to Him be all the glory.

Whichever service(s) you attend, I do wish you the most wonderful of holidays!
