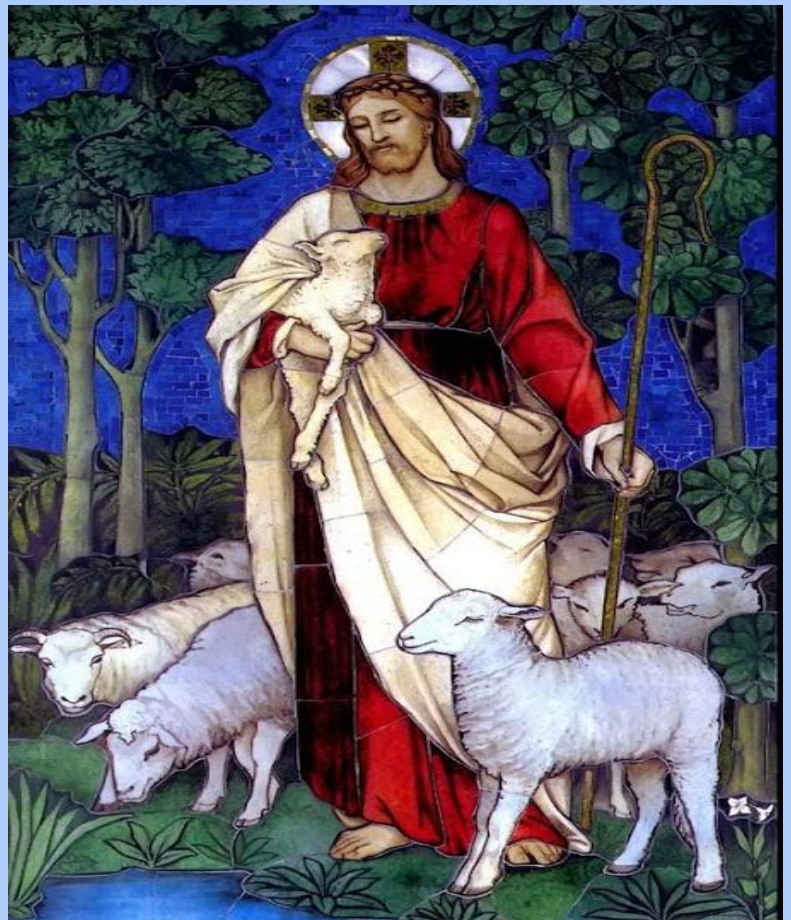

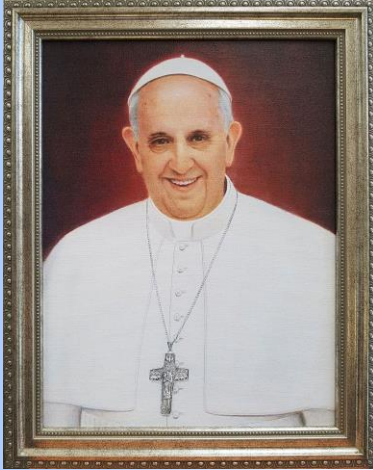

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN



From an address by Pope Francis: There are often two kinds of priests (neither of which is ideal):

1. The priest who preaches fire and brimstone (for example: adultery yields hell) and then immediately leaves after Mass and goes to the rectory and closes the door.
2. The priest who tells the people that sin doesn't matter and that everything is fine.

Don't tell that child of God that sin doesn't matter! "*The wage of sin is death*" (Romans 6:23)! The purpose of the priest is to bring the truth, and the truth is a person (Jesus Christ), and we are supposed to embody that person. So preach the truth, even the hard truth, and then walk with people in it.

The authentic priest speaks the truth in kindness and then walks with the people in their mess. The priest must know the way to cavalry himself and keep walking it over and over again with the people. That is their salvation. This is the priest's vocation and salvation.

Suffering stretches the human heart. St. Augustine wrote, "God has deemed it better to permit evil and suffering and to bring good from it." What did God do with the worst suffering (the Cross)? The Resurrection.

* * * * *

Note from Father John: This is a hard message, isn't it? It causes me to pause and consider my own attitude of the wages of sin and death and the power that flows from the Eucharist. John writes in his gospel at 8:32 of the power of truth; "*... the truth will set you free.*" I pray for the grace to fulfill what Pope Francis is asking of us; truth, love, and the ability to not only carry our own Cross, but help others carry theirs. This is my prayer; won't you join me?
