A REFLECTION

FROM DEACON ALBERT

*I am the vine; you are the branches.
Whoever remains in me and I in him will
bear much fruit.*

When we look at the connection between a vine and its branches, we can glimpse the intimate nature of the relationship between Jesus and his followers. A vine is made up of its branches. The life of the vine is the life of the branches. Jesus lives in his branches and his branches live in his life. The vine bears fruit through the branches and the branches bear the fruit of the vine.

The basis of this union is the acceptance and fidelity to the teachings of Jesus. The importance of remaining faithful to his teachings cannot be overemphasized. And so in the Gospel today we hear repeatedly: *remain in me and I will remain in you and you will bear much fruit.*

There is one place in the New Testament where Jesus himself tells us how to remain in him; John 6:56. *“Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one*

who feeds on me will have life because of me.” This was during the great Bread of Life discourse where Jesus made clear that He was the Bread that came down from heaven.

Many disciples chose not to remain in him and departed from him. They could not, or would not, accept his teaching. The twelve, however, chose to stay. Although they could not have understood what he meant at the time, they knew him enough to trust in him. And after the Last Supper and then the Resurrection, they understood.

We too, have the choice to remain in him. We are fortunate to not only have the teaching of Jesus to rely on, but the testimony of the Apostles and those who came after to explain what seemed so hard to understand. We don't have to wonder what he meant by eat his flesh or drink his blood, we know perfectly well now that he was talking about the Holy Eucharist.

So remain in him. And he will remain in you!

It is a Divine promise.
