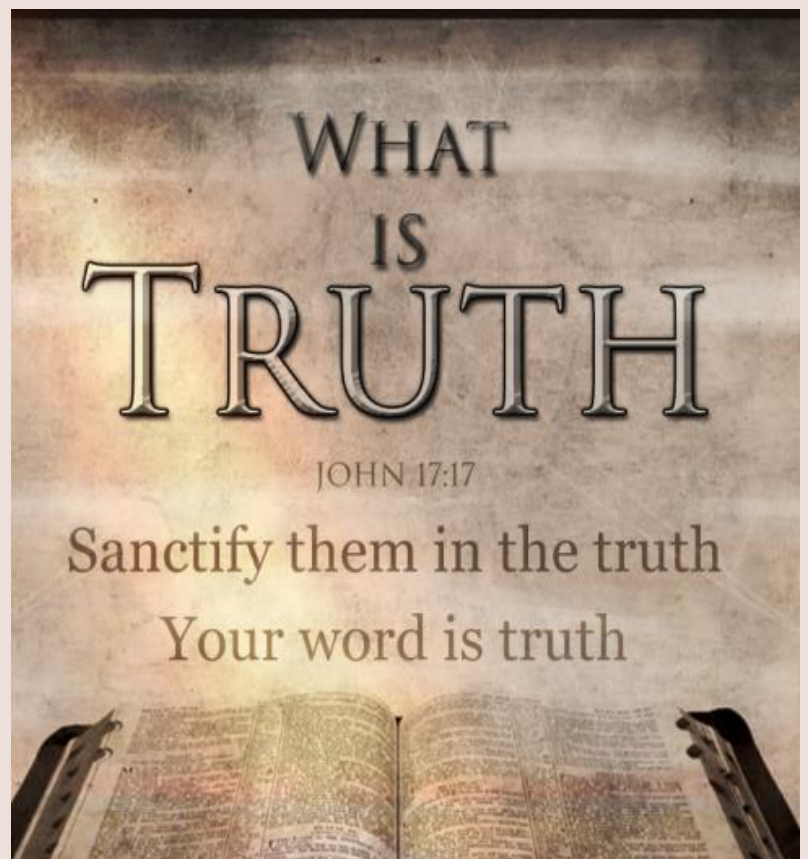

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

**(Catechism of the Catholic Church
#350-353)**

Angels are spiritual creatures who glorify God without ceasing and who serve his saving plans for other creatures: "The angels work together for the benefit of us all" (St. Thomas Aquinas).

The angels surround Christ their Lord. They serve him especially in the accomplishment of his saving mission to men.

The Church venerates the angels who help her on her earthly pilgrimage and protect every human being.

God willed the diversity of his creatures and their own particular goodness, their interdependence and their order. He destined all material creatures for the good of the human race. Man, and through him all creation, is destined for the glory of God.

Article 350-353 of the Catechism summarizes church teachings on "angels." (For more information look to the Catechism #328-336.) There is a beautiful poetry here, remembering the angels, especially in our Guardian Angels and Patron Saints.

It is humbling each of us has a Guardian Angel for our mortal journey. Again, according to the Catechism, "from infancy

to death human life is surrounded by their watchful care and intercession. Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading them to life."

Patron Saints are identified by Popes in relation to human needs. We pray to Patron Saints for specific intercession with Christ the Lord. For instance, Joseph is the Patron Saint of workers and fathers and St. Anne is the patron saint of mothers, stemming from her status as the mother of Mary, who was the mother of Christ. Most trades also have Patron Saints, and if you are looking for a particular intercession, consult "Google" to find out who will help you pray for your need.

Patron Saints also take the form of archangels, as the Patron Saints of Angels. Archangels have also appeared according to scripture. The Archangel Michael appears in the book of Daniel, Revelation, and the Epistle to Jude. Over time and through Tradition, Michael's role became one of a protector and the leader of the army of God against the forces of evil. The powerful prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel calls on Michael to fill that role in our lives as we battle the conditions of a fallen world.



As we languish in the waning days of the Easter Season, join me in praying for and with the angels and saints.
