A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

The Dogmatic Constitution of the Church informs us on the mission of the Holy Spirit: “When the Son completed the work with which the Father had entrusted him on earth, the Holy Spirit was sent on the day of Pentecost to sanctify the Church unceasingly and thus enable believers to have access to the Father through Christ in the one Spirit.” This weekend we celebrate that day, Pentecost, the day the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the men and women of the Church.

“The Spirit dwells in the Church and in the hearts of the faithful as in a temple.” In the Church the Holy Spirit leads us into all truth and supports unity in communion and in service. This unity echoes the unity of the Trinity - the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The unity of the Holy Spirit guides God’s people by the Sacraments and through our ministries to spread the Kingdom of God here on earth.

The Holy Spirit “distributes special graces among the faithful of every state of life, *assigning his gifts to each as he chooses.*” These are called ‘charisms’, and every person has received gifts. In his letter to the Corinthians, the Apostle Paul describes some of the gifts of the Spirit:

To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. To one is given through the Spirit the expression of wisdom; to another the expression of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit; to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit; to another mighty deeds; to another prophecy; to another discernment of spirits; to another varieties of tongues; to another interpretation of tongues.

“These charisms, the simpler and more widespread as well as the most outstanding, should be accepted with a sense of gratitude and consolation, since in a very special way they answer and serve the needs of the Church.”

How will you share your charisms with the Church and with the world?
