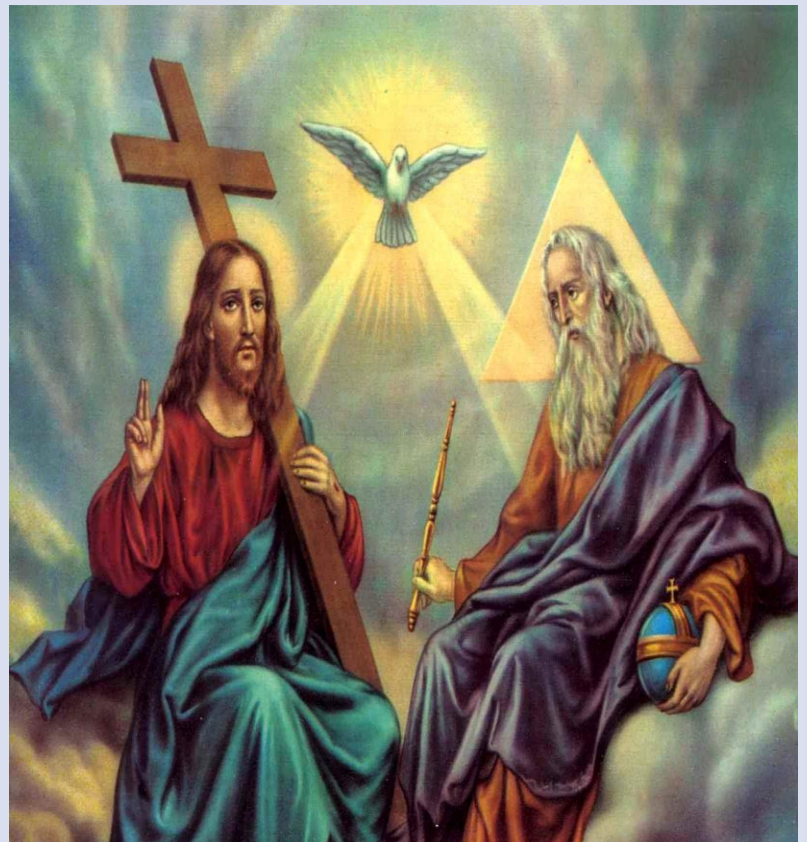

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

Next weekend is a great event for the Diocese of Evansville. Deacon Garrett Braun will be admitted to Holy Orders of the Church, one of our seven sacraments: Baptism, Confession, Eucharist, Confirmation, Matrimony, the Sacrament of the Sick, and Holy Orders.

Holy Orders are received in the office of deacon, priest, and bishop. The word 'order' designates a body, especially a governing body. Introduction into the order comes by way of ordination. It confers the gift of the Holy Spirit by the 'laying on of hands,' by the Bishop along with a consecratory prayer.

At the ordination of priests, the Church prays:

Lord, holy Father, . . .

when you had appointed high priests to rule your people,

you chose other men next to them in rank and dignity

to be with them and to help them in their task.

. . . you extended the spirit of Moses to seventy wise men. . . .

You shared among the sons of Aaron the fullness of their father's power.

The common priesthood of the people of God is brought about in the unfolding of

baptismal grace, a life of faith, hope, and charity according to the Spirit. Every baptized person shares in this common priesthood.

The ministerial priesthood of which Garrett is being ordained is in the service of the common priesthood; it is directed at the unfolding of the baptismal grace of all Christians. It is the means by which Christ unceasingly builds up and leads his Church. This is the reason it is transmitted by its own sacrament, the sacrament of Holy Orders.

Saint Thomas Aquinas said this of the priesthood, "Christ is the source of all priesthood: the priest of the old law was a figure of Christ, and the priest of the new law acts in the person of Christ."

Acting in the person of Christ, *persona Christi Capitis*. In the sacraments the priest acts in the person of Christ. This presence of Christ is not understood as if the priest is preserved from all human weaknesses, or even sin. But that presence does extend to all the sacraments, so that even a minister's sin cannot impede the fruit of grace and the apostolic fruitfulness of the Church.

Garrett's celebration will begin with a holy hour of prayer on Friday evening at 7:00 PM CST at the Cathedral and his Ordination on Saturday morning at 10:00 AM CST. As we move through our week, let us take the time to pray for Garrett as he moves toward the ordination that comes after a decade of prayer and service in the Church.

MORE ITEMS OF NOTE:

- **Evening of Adoration: Friday, June 4, at 7:00 pm C.D.T.** (Evansville time), at St. Benedict Cathedral in Evansville, in celebration of the ordination to the Priesthood of **Deacon Garrett Braun**. This evening of prayer and worship before the Blessed Sacrament is an opportunity to pray for Deacon Garrett as he prepares for ordination the following day. - **Effective June 11**, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, **the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is hereby lifted throughout the state of Indiana**. Those who are otherwise healthy are obliged to return to Sunday Mass by the weekend of June 12-13, 2021.
- **Catholic Center Summer Schedule – May 21 - July 31**, the Catholic Center will close at Noon CDT on Fridays.
