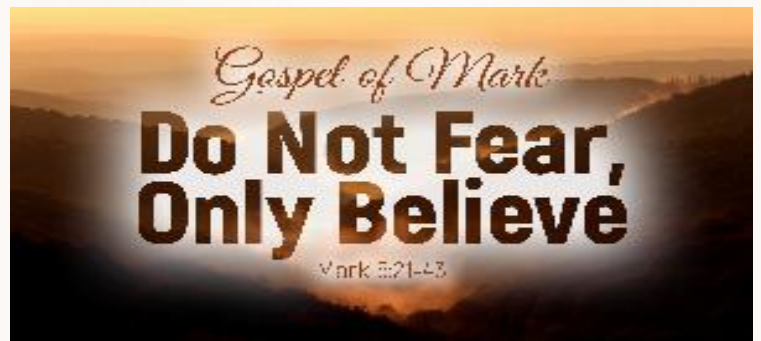

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

For my reflection, I wanted to review a few of the shows available to St. Mary and Saint Joan of Arc through the FORMED website. If you have signed up for FORMED you can watch at any time. If you have not signed up, it is easy to do:

- Go to FORMED.org on the internet,
- Sign up as a parishioner, find our Parish with the zip code 47882,
- Enter your name and email address and you are ready to go.

One series I wanted to highlight is called Symbolon. In a fascinating systematic presentation of the Catholic faith using the Creed as the guide, Symbolon allows the viewer a deeper understanding of Catholicism. The segments are short and visually stunning and teach the viewer the tenants of the faith in an understandable way. Ten short segments of knowing the faith and ten short segments on living the faith round out the series.

The series on the Sacraments is meant for parents and catechists that teach about the most sacred ceremonies of our faith. Whether you are receiving your first

communion, getting married, or having a child baptized, this series prepares you for a working overview and explanation of the Sacrament.

FORMED has programming for the whole family, including news interview shows, kids programming, and family movies. All are delivered to your computer with a single click. Also available are history shows and of course, the lives of selected saints.

If you enjoy praying, but would prefer to pray with a structured program, FORMED has an excellent novena to Saint Joseph. A novena is nine consecutive days of prayer, and a link provides handouts of the prayers. Each day reflects on one of the “titles” given to Saint Joseph. This novena takes about five minutes and is an excellent way to enrich your prayer life in the Year of Saint Joseph.
